### **1<sup>st</sup> Grade - Please put names on everything**

1	Expo Fine Tip Dry Erase Markers- Pack of 4 - <b>Black</b>
2	Boxes of 16-24 Crayons
1	Watercolor Paint Set (8 count)
1	Fiskars Scissors for Kids
1	Composition Notebook
1	Wide Lined Spiral Notebook
3	Pocket Folders with Prongs – <b>Green, Blue, Yellow</b>
1	Set of Headphones ( <b>no ear buds please</b> )
1	Paint Shirt – for use in Art (oversized T-shirt recommended)
1	White T-Shirt for 100's day – does not have to be new
1	Gym Shoes to be left at School – Optional Tennis Shoes must be worn on gym days
